

A LETTER TO Our Parents

Assalamu Alaikum parents,



All assigned summer work is mandatory and should be completed before the start of the new school year. Students should take their time, work neatly, and carefully review their answers. Completing their summer work with care will help them return to school feeling prepared and confident for the year ahead.



Parents are encouraged to support their child as needed and check their work periodically to ensure they are building a strong understanding of the material. Please make sure that all completed summer work, including math, phonics, handwriting or cursive if assigned, reading logs, and any other assigned materials, is returned to school at the beginning of the new school year.



In addition to their written work, students are expected to read three books over the summer. These books may be selected from the provided reading list. I encourage parents to help their child choose books by first reading the book descriptions online. If a book sounds interesting, visit your local library or bookstore and have your child open to a random page or chapter to read for a few minutes. If they are engaged and interested after reading, it is likely a good choice. Repeat this process until your child has selected three books that are both enjoyable and appropriate for their reading level.



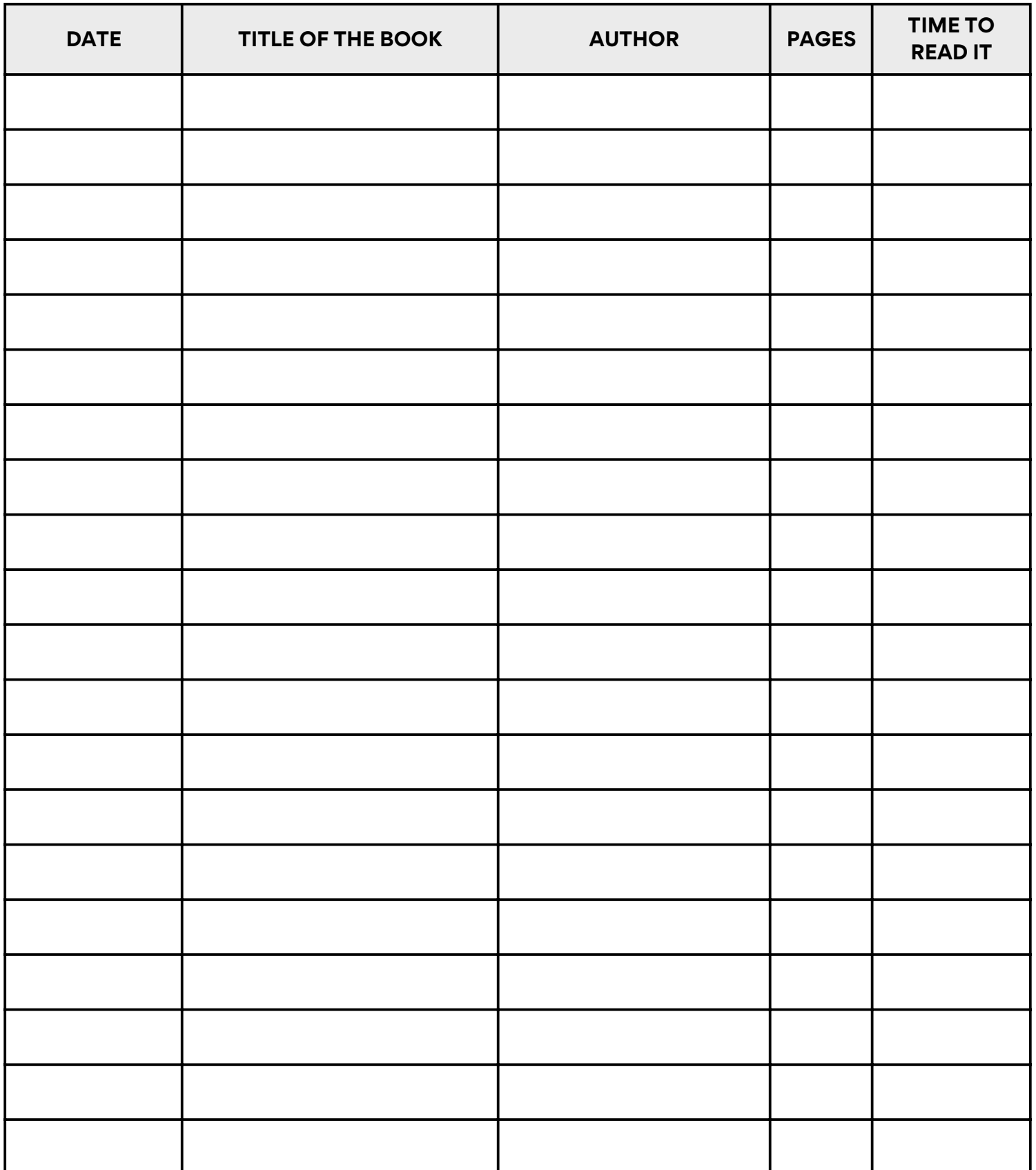
When students return to school, they will be expected to narrate each of the three books they have read. Narration is the practice of retelling a story in their own words. Students should be able to describe the main characters, important events, the problem, the solution, and any meaningful lessons or themes from the story. Practicing oral narration after each chapter or reading session throughout the summer will help students strengthen their comprehension, memory, and communication skills while preparing them for a successful school year.
